Dirt Road Aussies (Seller) and the Buyer agree that the puppy described above is a Purebred Standard Australian Shepherd. The kennel name "Dirt Road Aussies" MUST be included at the end of the registered name chosen by the Buyer for this puppy. Registration papers will be filled out upon completion of the sale. If papers are unavailable at the time of sale due to any reason, papers will be forwarded to the Buyer upon being received by the Seller. Dirt Road Aussies will provide all necessary paperwork for the registration with ASDR.

Conditions of Sale:

Dirt Road Aussies requires a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 to hold above mentioned puppy. This amount will be applied to the total cost of the puppy. The puppy will not be provided to the Buyer until full payment is received in cash at pickup, AND the puppy is at least 8 weeks of age. In the event that puppy becomes unsellable or dies prior to purchase, the Buyer will have the option to pick another puppy if one is available. If a replacement is unavailable the Seller will refund the deposit to the Buyer.

Transportation:

Transport by the Seller can be arranged with the first 30 miles included in the purchase price. Transport beyond 30 miles traveled by the Seller, the Buyer will be charged \$.58/mile to be collected in cash at pickup along with the remaining balance. Dirt Road Aussies will do it's best to try to incorporate multiple deliveries when possible and cost-share the delivery fee among the Buyers. Dirt Road Aussies reserves the right to offer specials on transport.

Adoption Agreement:

If for any reason you can no longer care for the puppy yourself and plan to sell the puppy for any reason you MUST contact the Seller prior to making any arrangements to sell, give away, abandon, etc. Dirt Road Aussies reserves the right to aid in finding a new home for the animal. In case of this event, no refund or compensation will be given to Buyer referenced in this contract. Dirt Road Aussies shall have first right of refusal in relation to any new home the animal may be sent to.

Dirt Road Aussies will accept the return of any puppy sold in order to help rehome the puppy. If Buyer does not inform Dirt Road Aussies of any event mentioned above, the Buyer named in this contract agrees to pay any and all expenses Dirt Road Aussies may incur, to get this animal back to Dirt Road Aussies up to \$1,500.

Health Guarantee:

Dirt Road Aussies guarantees the puppy to be in good health and free of genetic and congenital defects to the best of our knowledge. The puppy is guaranteed to be free from genetic defects for the first 1 year of his/her life. Should the dog develop a genetic defect within this 1-year time frame, the dog will be replaced with another dog of equal value when one is available. Dirt Road Aussies cannot guarantee color or gender upon replacement and proof of the defect must be provided by a registered veterinarian.

The puppy will be current on all vaccines and worming as suggested by Dirt Road Aussies practicing veterinarian and Buyer will be provided with those records at pickup. Buyer has 3 business days to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian for general health from date of delivery or this health guarantee will be voided. Under no circumstances will Dirt Road Aussies except any liability for communicable diseases. If the puppy does not pass a general health exam due to genetic or congenital defect, Buyer agrees to notify the Seller within 24 hours and provide a copy of this signed licensed veterinary statement within 48 hours of exam.

Although it is made with every effort to avoid minor, treatable problems (diarrhea, coccidiosis, parasites etc.) it is understood that these are unfortunately common issues especially under stress of anything new and will not be covered by the Health Guarantee.

Additional Provisions and Terms of Sale

If puppy is purchased without breeding rights, the Buyer agrees to spay or neuter the puppy no sooner than 6 months of age and no later than 18 months of age. Seller will be listed as the owner of the puppy on all microchip information, once proof of spay/neuter surgery is provided to the Seller, assuming no other contract clauses have been broken, all microchip ownership information will be turned over to the Buyer. If Buyer fails to spay/neuter the animal within the given timeframe, Seller reserves the right to take possession of the animal described above. If dog is bred and breeding rights have not been purchased- there will be a \$2,000 fine. However, if Buyer decides to pursue breeding after signing this contract, Buyer MUST contact Dirt Road Aussies to pay an additional \$300 for full rights of the animal, along with signing a new contract. Once balance is paid and contract is signed and received by Seller, Dirt Road Aussies will surrender all microchip ownership information immediately.
